The above election will be held in Durham County, NC on 5/8/2018. All polling places will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

17 year old voters who are registered and will be 18 years old on or before 11/6/2018 may vote in primary contests. Party primaries will be open to voters registered to that respective party, and to unaffiliated voters as allowed by the party.

### **ADVANCE VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE AND LAST OPPORTUNITY FOR REGISTERED VOTERS TO**

**CHANGE PARTY AFFILIATION:** Friday, 4/13/2018. Voters that miss the registration deadline may register and vote during early voting.

**SAME-DAY REGISTRATION DURING EARLY VOTING:** Voters are allowed to register and vote during early voting. It is quicker and easier to register in advance, but if you have not registered in advance, you can do so during early voting with proper identification. This same-day registration is not allowed at polling places on Election Day.

### **NOTICE OF RESOLUTION TO ADOPT TIME FOR COUNTING OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

On 1/25/2018, the Durham Board of Elections met at its office at 201 N. Roxboro St., Durham, and adopted a resolution of the following effect:

1. The Board of Elections shall meet at 2:00 p.m. on Primary Election Day, Tuesday, 5/8/2018 at its office to count absentee ballots.
2. The results of the absentee ballot count will not be announced before 7:30 p.m. on the date of the primary/election.
3. The Board of Elections shall meet at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, 5/17/2018 at its office to count additional timely-received absentee ballots prior to county canvass.
4. Any voter of the county may attend these meetings.
