The Durham County Board of Elections is currently accepting entries for an “I Voted” sticker that’s representative of the Bull City community. Entries will be accepted through the month of July. The winning design will be selected in August and will appear on “I Voted” stickers in the 2018 General Election. **Starting this fall, these stickers will be handed to every voter in Durham** voting early (Wed., Oct. 17 through Sat., Nov. 3) and on Election Day (Tues. Nov. 6)!

- In August, we plan to provide the public with an opportunity to vote for the winning design. **Watch for details after the submission deadline on our website (www.dconcl.gov/elect) and Facebook page**
- **Submission format:** 2-inch circle format (may not reflect final production size)
- Please send entries electronically as attachments to elections@dconcl.gov in high-quality JPG or PDF format, along with any native graphics files (.psd, .eps, etc.)
- By entering this contest, designers waive all further creative and legal rights to the design. However, the winning designer will be publicly recognized by the Durham County Board of Elections and other local governments and receive a prize package.
